

STUDENT CLUBS



Student clubs aim to develop students' social, educational and leadership skills. Allowing students to communicate effectively and participate in scientific, engaging activities. The opportunity to enroll in student clubs provides valuable leadership and life skills.

Formation of New Student Clubs

AFU encourages students to form student clubs that reflect their interests and activities. Based on the student needs and current educational, social trends, the Deanship of Student Affairs can form new student clubs; additionally, AFU students are given also the opportunity to form their own clubs based on their interests. In order to form a new club, students submit a formal proposal letter to the Deanship of Student Affairs. Consequently and in coordination with the Student Deanship and the Media Office, approved student clubs could then promote their clubs and encourage other students to become members via AFU's official social media accounts and on-campus-printed announcements. By filling the registration form in Deanship of Student Affairs, new members can join the newly established clubs. Collectively, each student club consists of 6 (minimum) to 10 (maximum) members and runs for one academic year. Designated club coordinators, faculty members specialized in the club's field, aim to advice club members on club activities and provide an academic insight to the areas of the club.



- ✓ All Clubs should be approved by the University Administration.
- ✓ The proposal letter should clarify the purpose of the club and be submitted during the first 2 months of Fall Semester of each year.

Renewing/ Joining an Existing Club

Communicating with Deanship of Student Affairs, club members who wish to renew the club for the next academic year are required to nominate and elect the succeeding club officers. Furthermore, any student wishes to join an existing club can submit the registration form at the Deanship of Student Affairs.

Club Financial Support and Funding

At the beginning of each academic semester, the club members present the club's planned activities, events and resources requisite, in addition to the financial requirements. Furthermore, the financial support is provided by the Deanship of Student Affairs to strategically support clubs' activities and events.

- ✓ Deanship of Student Affairs holds the right to approve or reject funding a clubs' event/activity based on the information provided and the nature of the event/activity.

Desired Structure of Student Clubs

The club is expected to regularly meet for planning and organizing activities and events to meet the club's objectives.
