

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS



AFU Students are eligible to graduate and obtain a degree from AFU upon fulfilling the following requirements:

- The student must be registered at AFU during their graduation semester.
- The student has successfully completed all the required courses according to his/her major's study plan.
- The student's final CGPA is no less than 2.0 on a scale of 4.0 for Bachelor degree and 3.0 on scale of 4.0 for Master degree
- The student met the graduation eligibility period, by not exceeding the maximum number of years for graduation as stated in program duration policy.

### COLLEGE OF MASS COMMUNICATION

**Bachelor of Mass Communication:** A bachelor degree is granted after a successful completion of the required credit hours and cumulative grade point average as following:

- A student must complete 126 credit hours as follows:
  - General Education Courses Compulsory: 21 credit hours
  - General Education Courses Elective: 9 credit hours
  - College Courses: 60 credit hours
  - College Elective Courses: 9 credit hours
  - Major Compulsory Courses: 27 credit hours
- The minimum cumulative grade point average required for a bachelor degree is 2.00.
- Transfer students from other institutions must complete at least 50% of the required credit hours at AFU.
- The last 30 required credit hours of the study plans must be completed at AFU
- The minimum period of enrollment for the completion of a requirement is 6 regular semesters (inapplicable to transferred students)
- The maximum period of enrollment for the completion of a requirement is 14 regular semesters.
