

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS



AFU Students are eligible to graduate and obtain a degree from AFU upon fulfilling the following requirements:

- The student must be registered at AFU during their graduation semester.
- The student has successfully completed all the required courses according to his/her major's study plan.
- The student's final CGPA is no less than 2.0 on a scale of 4.0 for Bachelor degree and 3.0 on scale of 4.0 for Master degree

The student met the graduation eligibility period, by not exceeding the maximum number of years for graduation as stated in program duration policy.

COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Master of Business Administration: A master degree is granted after a successful completion of the required credit hours and cumulative grade point average as following:

- A student must complete 36 credit hours as follows:
 - Core Courses: 21 credit hours
 - Concentration Courses: 15 credit hours
- The minimum cumulative grade point average required for a MBA degree is 3.00.
- Transfer students from other institutions must complete at least 75% of the required credit hours at AFU.
- The credit hour is the basic unit of measure for course credit. All courses at AFU are offered for three credit hours. Each credit hour is the number of hours that a student should spend in class per week during a semester. If a course is three credits, it converts to three hours of class time per week for that course. Each degree plan has a certain number of credits you need to complete in order to graduate. The number of credits assigned to each course is used in the calculation of the student grade point average.
