And to prepare for CAA Initial Accreditation and Re-accreditation visits; develop responses to External Review Team Reports, as required; and to prepare all documentations required for the purposes of the application to international accrediting bodies for programs.

Responsibilities

1. Review of course files and ensure timely completion of Course Portfolio and prepare reports on course portfolio development for the Deans Council.
2. Review of academic schedules to ensure faculty qualifications and sufficiency.
3. Review and follow up appropriately regarding agreed minor and substantive curriculum and program changes.
4. Arrange for program reviews as necessary, to ensure consistency with CAA Standards.
5. Prepare responses to the Reports of External Review Teams concerning programs reviewed as necessary.
6. Prepare initial application for new agreed programs in accordance to local and international standards.
